-God first, our needs second: Matthew 6: 25-34.

Hallowed be Your Name

-Name: Exodus 3: 6, 14.

-Hallowed: Psalms 47, 96, 99; Hebrews 13: 15-16.

Meditation: Spend some time quietly praising and adoring God for who he is, a holy, merciful, and compassionate Father. Recall God's holiness and compassion in Jesus Christ, in creation, and in our relationships.

Your Kingdom Come Your Will be done

-Kingdom: Rom. 8: 12-17; Gal. 4: 6-7.

-Come: Rom. 8: 22-25; Phil. 2: 9-11.

God's will: Psalm 119: 1-16.

Meditation: Quietly meditate on what it means to ask for God's Kingdom to come. Pray for God's rule to be in our hearts and minds. God's rule to come into the lives of those who have not yet accepted him.

On Earth as it is in Heaven

-On earth: Matthew 5, 6, 7.

-World, flesh, devil: 1 John 2: 15-17; Gal. 5: 16-21.

Meditation: Welcome and acknowledge God's influence in your life and in the world. Think about what God's will for you is in relation to family problems and relationships; planning your future: school, career, retirement.
